Role of Assiut university in promoting SDGs:

Our university play an important role in promoting SDGs in increase local awareness about SDGs this is clear in annual university reports for each SDG and also Strategic objectives for next 5 years to SDGs:

❖ Improving the operational capacity of the registry service and environmental protection sector by:

- Supporting scientific research and practical innovation within the university.
- Developing innovative teaching methods and using modern techniques in teaching.
- Developing the basic infrastructure.

❖ Improving special centers by:

- Challenge the identification data of centers and units with a special character.
- Identify some centers and units with a special character attractive to the systems.
- Activate cooperation between centers and organizations affiliated with the registry service and environmental engineering sector at the university with academic and international centers and organizations.



- Develop a strategy for the performance of the activity and the implementation of the specific requirements.

❖ **International cooperation to solve environmental problems by:**

- Maintaining international partnerships and exchanging expertise to achieve sustainable development.
- Enhancing communication with civil society.
- Updating the university's international archives and enhancing international cooperation
- Enhancing civil society partnerships.

❖ **Improving scientific research to achieve sustainable development by:**

- Support scientific research in the fields of sustainable development.
- Evaluate and measure the progress of health institutions in achieving the goals of sustainable development.

❖ **Improving crisis and disaster management and public accountability by:**

- Supporting health records and health needs through social initiatives.
- Challenge the lack of safety and security within the university campus.
- Implementing transparent policies and promoting good governance within the university.
- Implementing policies and programs to enhance equity and social opportunities.
- Maintaining environmental activity within the university campus and natural beaches.
- Implementing strategies to reduce carbon emissions and improve the efficiency of energy use.
- Developing programs for waste management and recycling.
- Developing strategies to account for and rationalize the use of natural resources.



- Challenge the university infrastructure to be more sustainable and efficient.
- Reducing economic and social gaps between the poor and enhancing the opportunities available to them.
- Encouraging research and developmental studies to account for the environmental and social impacts of the poor.

❖ **Follow-up and care for graduates by:**

- Encounter the new education system and develop comprehensive and sustainable approaches.

❖ **Improving the financial resources of the registry service and environmental protection sector by:**

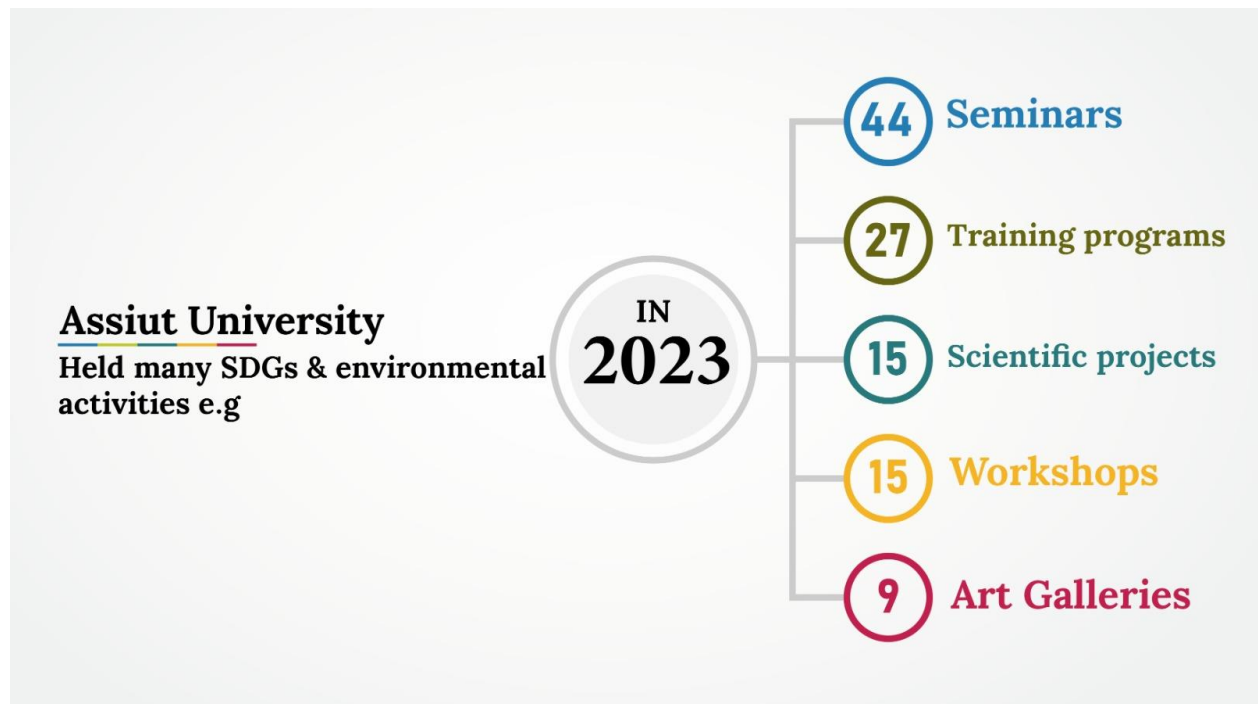
- Developed the educational efficiency and enhance the financial sustainability
- Marketing the university services.

❖ **Improving the health services provided to the registry by:**

- Providing comprehensive health services and enhancing oral and new well-being.
- Expansion in the rural and urban areas of Assiut Governorate and the surrounding governorate.

❖ **Supporting the leadership of the private sector and companies by:**

- Encouraging entrepreneurship and innovation in cultural and artistic fields.



- In 2023 Assiut University held many SDGs & environmental activities e.g. 44 seminars, 27 training programs, 15 scientific projects, 15 workshops and 9 Art Galleries. Assiut university also signed nearly 33 cooperation protocols with various universities in Egypt and outside (e.g. Turkey, Sudan, Germany, India, Russia, Hungary, China, Roma,



Italy, Bahrain, Portugal, Romania, Chile and USA). Our university had main concern about research specially in field SDGs, so we have 4619 scholarly output related SDGs only in period 2019 to 2023.

- Also, in undergraduate teaching, there were many courses related to the environment and sustainability offered by the university: A total of 312 courses related to the environment and sustainability out of a total of 3,557, which is 8.7%, and 134 courses at the postgraduate level.





➤ In 2023 was special point for Assiut university in cooperation with non-governmental organization (NGOs) as it launched out special center for support NGOs and did many cooperation protocols with 9 NGOs and more than 10 activities with those NGOs.

➤ Assiut university participate nearly in all SDGs and environmental related international ranking and also achieved good position among national and international universities.
