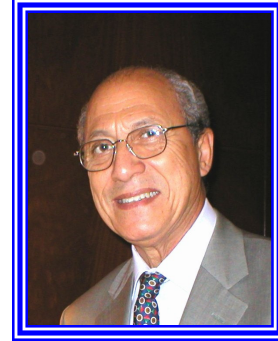

## Distinct Achievements:

### Establishment of the Department of Orthopedic and Trauma Surgery, Faculty of Medicine Assiut University.

Assiut University is the fourth University in Egypt, established in 1957. I joined Assiut University in 1962. As I finished my training in Cairo University Hospitals and obtaining my Doctorate Degree in Orthopedic Surgery, I moved to Assiut in 1964.

I was the first staff member in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery. I had the assignment of starting that Department: provide it with equipment, treat patients, train resident doctors, and teach under graduate students for eight years until the next staff member was appointed. I continued chairing the Department, modernizing, equipping and staffing it until 1996.

The Department has now 26 staff members, 14 assistant lecturers and 23 residents. All staff members are my students, whom I have taught, mentored, supervised their theses and promoted to higher posts. This also applies to most of the staff members in El Minia, Sohag and South Valley Universities. The Department of Orthopedic and Trauma Surgery in Assiut University Hospitals has 105 beds for orthopedics, 80 beds for casualties, 25 beds for septic case, and 20 beds for intensive care.

The Department now comprises the following subspecialties: Spine, Joint replacement, Sports Medicine and Arthroscopy, Bone Tumors, Pediatric Orthopedics and Microsurgery and Hand.

Assiut University Hospital is a third referral hospital serving all Upper Egypt (20 millions) and many Arab and African countries. Many difficult and complicated cases are referred to it, providing a unique opportunity of extensive experience.

### Teaching Orthopedic and Trauma Surgery

- Teaching Orthopedic and Trauma surgery to all medical students of Assiut University since 1965 until now.
- Teaching post-graduates, practicing in Egypt, Arab and African countries.

- Teacher and mentor of all staff members of the Department of Orthopedic Surgery in Assiut University, and most of those in Minia Sohag and South Valley Universities.
- Supervised 53 Master and 28 Doctorate Degrees Theses.
- Discussor or reviewer of 145 Master and Doctorate Theses or articles for International Journals and Congresses.
- Reviewer of hundreds of articles presented to the Standing Committee for Promotion of Professors over 30 years of membership.
- Teaching young orthopedic surgeons through out all the country, through scientific meetings, conferences, seminars and work-shops in different parts of Egypt.
- Establishment of a permanent local AO workshop and holding a yearly Basic AO Course and Workshop in Cairo in collaboration with AO International, for training on fracture treatment.

Assiut University/ SICOT Training Program  
For African Doctors.

I established this continuous Training Program for African orthopedic surgeons. According to this Program 2-4 young African Orthopedic Surgeons are trained in the Department of Orthopedic and Trauma Surgery, Assiut University Hospital, for 6 months. The hospital provides them with free accommodation, and meals. SICOT pays the air ticket fare, and SICOT Foundation donates \$ 200 per month for every fellow, as pocket money. Since the program started in February 2002, we have trained 39doctors from Sudan, Kenya, Chad, Zambia, Uganda, Nigeria, Niger, Ethiopia, Burundi and Tanzania. Exit reports of the Fellows were published in several SICOT News Letters.

Voluntary Community Services

- Establishment of the Rehabilitation Center for Disabled Boys, Assiut, 1969: where 40 boarding disabled boys are rehabilitated medically, physically and vocationally. A workshop for prosthetics and orthotics is attached to that Center.

- Establishment of Assiut Childhood and Development Association (ACDA), 1991: This association implements comprehensive development projects in Assiut Governorate.
