Abstract:

The insertions of the extraocular muscles in sheep and goats are characterized by many common anatomical features but there are some differences between sheep and goats concerning the insertions of the dorsal and medial recti, the ventral oblique and the retractor bulbi muscles. The study of the insertions of the extraocular muscles is of importance for the treatment of some surgical affections of the eyeball, and in forensic medicine.
