# Urethral obstruction in Rams (Experimental study). 1- Clinical and Haematological Pictures

## Abstract:

Clinical and haematological changes occurring in rams with experimental urethral obstruction included the following: 1- A lowered body temperature postoperation. In the contrary pulse and respiration were accelerated. 2- Blood haemoglobin content and P.C.V. values decreased with severity of uraemia. Respective values up to 6,5 gm/100 ml and 17% for P.C.V, were recorded at time of death. No correlation between total leucocyte count and severity of uraemia was achieved
