# Clinical and Haematological Study on Rams with Experimental Rupture of Urinary bladder

## Abstract:

Four healthy balady rams were used for experimental rupture of the urinary bladder. The present study revealed the following results: □The operation influenced the body temperature, pulse and respiratory rates at variable degrees. □Transient increase of P.C.V. followed by fluctuations of this indice during the period of the experiment. At time of death PCV Value was low in three-rams. □Lowered Hb concentration was evident at first 12 hours followed by general tendency to decrease till time of death. □Variable degree of leucocytosis.
