Participation in the Life Skills Development Training Program for University Security Personnel about two topics:-

-Managing dialogue and interaction with others and ethics of university security personnel, managing dialogue and its impact on action, and understanding how to deal with others and accept their views.

-Definition and comparison of dialogue with controversy, identification of methods and ethics of dialogue and classifying it into negative and positive dialogue, reasons for disagreement between interlocutors (Why are people different?), interest in values and their concept (for individuals and society),

the importance of work ethics and the reasons for its vulnerability, ethics that the employee must have.



Training program to combat terrorism and extremism:

The first training program started with the speech of the Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs at Assiut University and talking about the Ministry's strategy in confronting terrorism, and the vision of Assiut University in the face of all patterns of abnormal ideas within Assiut University, where the program was implemented for the first phase over a period of 6 days and the program included the following axes:-

- The takfiri mentality and (the psychology of takfiri thought) by knowing the motives of terrorism how the terrorist thinks provide participants with the concept of extremism and terrorism, takfir, manifestations of extremism in the university, causes and motives of extremism and related factors.
- Takfiri behavior patterns to provide participants with areas of extremism and moderation in human behavior, the intellectual tendencies of the extremist, and the differences between extremism and moderation.
- Mental and psychological construction of the extremist (university students as a model) to provide participants with the psychology of the intellectually extremist student, manifestations of intellectual and behavioral deviation within universities, personal patterns of the extremist student.
- How to influence the student's mentality to provide participants with sources of intellectual deviation and their relationship to personality, and how to recruit and influence students to fall into the clutches of extremism and terrorism.
- Skills for monitoring takfiri behaviors to provide participants with the concept of monitoring and discovery and related concepts, general characteristics of observers, methods of monitoring, the main principles of monitoring, how to make an observation index, and methods of planning the monitoring process.
- Skills of recording takfiri behaviors to provide participants with the concept of registration, general characteristics of registrants, registration methods, the main principles of registration, and the how to obtaining information from the student.

- Follow-up skills and report writing to provide participants with the concept of follow-up, follow-up mechanisms, follow-up systems, and how to write follow-up reports.
- CBT and working with extremists to provide participants with the concept of CBT, its mechanisms and how to use it with intellectually extremist students through cognitive and behavioral techniques.
- Skills of guidance and guidance of students in universities to provide participants with concepts, rules and skills of guidance and guidance in working with intellectually extremist students within universities.
- Skills for the prevention of takfiri thought in universities to provide participants with personality patterns, methods of prevention and guidance, and methods of parental treatment with students at risk of takfiri and extremist thought within universities.
- The extremist family how it works to provide participants with the concept of the family, family building and the factors leading to extremism within the family, family upbringing and its relationship to extremism.
- Peer culture and tendency to extremism to provide participants with the concept of spouse, the extreme tendencies of friends, how peers influence the mentality of the extremist, and how to dealing with it.
- Rational emotional therapy and working with extremists to provide participants with the concept of rational emotional therapy and its different methods and therapeutic techniques and steps in dealing with the extremist.
- Family therapy and work with providing participants with the concept of family therapy, its different methods and therapeutic techniques, its steps in dealing with the extremist, and the basic criteria for the use of family therapy in working with the extremist.





Part of the participation in the activities of the training program (Developing the skills of employees in supervision and residence in university cities) prepared by the General Directorate of Organization and Administration at Assiut University on Sunday, November 3, 2019. This is in a training session entitled The Psychology of Dealing with Students in University Cities.



Implementation of two training sessions on violence against women and communication skills with others at the Unit for Combating Violence and Discrimination at Assiut University, where the training dealt with the concept of violence and scientific theories explaining violence and the causes, forms and manifestations of violence against women and shed light on the psychological drivers associated with domestic violence and the effects of violence against women and how to reduce them and precautionary measures that reduce the phenomenon of domestic violence and guidelines that contribute to alleviating this phenomenon.



A seminar entitled Preventive Social Work and its Role in Mitigating Suicidal Thoughts was carried out by students of field training groups at the Faculty of Social Work, where the seminar dealt with the concept of suicide, how suicide thoughts form in young people, the causes of suicide and how to reduce it.



The great importance that the university attaches to the issue of terrorism in the face of all kinds of unequal ideas within its walls that grow in new forms may not have existed before. This underscores the role of university specialists in confronting this phenomenon so as to protect the youth of the university so that it is a generation capable of assuming and defending responsibility of the nation to organization of the Community Service and Environmental Development Sector for a training course titled “Qualifying social and psychological workers to confront extremism and takfiri thought in universities” in order to presence of Dr. Maha Ghanem, Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development Affairs, because the benefit from this course that the takfiri mentality and (the psychology of takfiri thought) by knowing the motives of terrorism how the terrorist thinks provide participants with the concept of extremism and terrorism, takfir, manifestations of extremism in the university, causes and motives of extremism and related factors and Peer culture and tendency to extremism to provide participants with the concept of spouse, the extreme tendencies of friends, how peers influence the mentality of the extremist, and how to dealing with it.



Preserving the family entity is something that needs many community bodies and institutions under Sponsorship of the Ministry of Social Solidarity, which seeks to raise the awareness of young people and change misconceptions among those who are about to marry young people through a number of training programs and seminars, in addition to all state

institutions in the hope of reducing divorce rates and preserving the family, as the training program includes the training of faculty members from the Student Activities Committee at the university who will take over the task of training and educating students at the university on the basis of building a family and how to choose a life partner, Methods of dealing with family problems and methods of solving them by scientific methods, Educating young people about the seriousness of domestic violence and its repercussions on marital life, The foundations of proper upbringing of children, The legitimate rights and duties of the spouses, Correcting misconceptions among young people about marriage.



Implementation of a training on the Mawaddah project for those who are about to get married, where the training dealt with the concept of marriage, the objectives and criteria for choosing a life partner and ways to deal with problems for children, lectured by Prof. Dr. Saud Mohammed Hassan.
