



## **Achievements of the Social Therapy and Family Counseling Center**

### **Faculty of Social Work, Assiut University**

#### **:First: Introduction to the Center**

Based on the role of the Faculty of Social Work, Assiut University, in developing the university and community, particularly with regard to bringing about desired change in the personalities of male and female students and working to remove all obstacles and problems facing the educational environment. The college also believes in the role of the family in shaping, nurturing, and refining the human personality and in advancing society, as it constitutes a pillar of social, cultural, and national security. Therefore, in light of the growing importance of this role, it was

necessary for the college to establish a Social Therapy and Family Counseling Unit to join the university's system of specialized units, strengthening its position on the map of community development and professional counseling in Upper Egypt in particular and the Arab .Republic of Egypt in general

The college sought and took the initiative to establish the Social Treatment and Family Counseling Center (S.T.F.C.C.) as a contribution to the university's self-development. This center aims to solve students' problems, satisfy their needs, and fulfill their aspirations for the development of the Egyptian family, represented by the Assiut community and neighboring governorates. This center aims to address the challenges they face and the obstacles that hinder their progress in fulfilling their civilizational mission. This center provides specialized and distinguished professional therapeutic and advisory services in support of its students, staff, and the community, and is committed to improving the .quality of life for those who visit and benefit from the center's services

The Social Treatment and Family Counseling Center is an established center to address the problems faced by university students that hinder the achievement of the desired educational goals. The center is one of the university's community service units, a special unit with financial and administrative independence, in accordance with the provisions of the executive regulations of Universities Law No. 49 issued by a presidential decree. Therefore, the Social Treatment Unit was established at the college on October 4, 2003. It was later transformed into the Center for Social Therapy and Family Counseling by decision of the Assiut University Council in December 2015. The importance of this center stems from its representation of the positive and effective relationship between the university and the community. In the modern era, the university is no longer merely a place for acquiring knowledge and learning, even though that is its primary function. Rather, its activities have expanded to include addressing societal problems through the application of theoretical and scientific frameworks, reviewing them on an ongoing basis to objectively identify their positives and negatives, and developing performance levels in line with the evolving and changing .conditions of society

## **:Second: The Center's Vision**

To achieve excellence in providing social therapy services, psychological counseling, rehabilitation, development and community awareness programs, and therapeutic-oriented training and cultural programs. This will position the center as a model of leadership and a center of expertise at the local, regional, and international levels. Third: The Center's :Mission

The Center seeks to enhance the role of Assiut University, represented by the College of Social Work, in providing a range of specialized and distinguished advisory services and programs in the fields of social therapy, awareness programs, and family rehabilitation for university students and staff. It also works to build bridges of mutual cooperation with community institutions by introducing the Center's scientific and professional capabilities and developing ongoing working relationships with these institutions within the framework of plans and programs aimed at addressing various issues, problems, and consultations of a therapeutic nature that the Center can help address. It also addresses the needs of these institutions regarding staff development and professional .performance

## **Fifth: Center Objectives**

The Center for Social Therapy and Family Counseling aims to achieve the following objectives

Assisting the university in fulfilling its educational mission by helping students adapt to university life, facilitating their use of the educational opportunities available to them .1

Assisting university students in overcoming academic problems they encounter during their enrollment, whether these problems are social, familial, or psychological in nature, which prevent them from engaging effectively in their studies .2

Providing social and psychological therapy services and individual and group family counseling for students and their families, within the center's capabilities, to support the university's relationship with the community .3

Conducting scientific research aimed at designing and implementing preventative programs for university students and the surrounding community, with the goal of protecting themselves and their families from social and psychological problems .4

Establishing cooperation and partnership protocols with civil and governmental entities to provide psychological, social, guidance, and family counseling to various community institutions .5

Organizing training courses and programs on therapeutic programs and professional interventions with clients for researchers and practitioners working with individuals .6

Designing therapeutic and counseling programs for university students that meet their needs and motivations and protect them from many destructive intellectual trends and behavioral deviations .7

Strengthening cultural, scientific, and professional ties between the .8  
The Center works with universities and various .two institutions community institutions by providing specialized technical advice on the design and implementation of social therapy and family counseling programs for relevant institutions in the community that require professional counseling

Publishing a periodic scientific journal on social therapy and family counseling, unifying the efforts of researchers and scholars in the field of social therapy and encouraging them to publish their research and scientific studies .9

Contributing to the development of training programs to develop the competencies of workers in the fields of social and family therapy in schools, educational institutions, mental health centers, social and vocational rehabilitation, and family courts. It also organizes seminars, conferences, workshops, and lectures that address issues of social therapy and psychological and family counseling at the scientific and applied levels .10

### **:Problems the Center Addresses**

A. Academic Problems: such as academic delay, poor concentration, frequent absences, truancy, poor academic adjustment, adolescent and youth problems, etc

Various Family Problems: such as marital disputes, divorce, child neglect, emotional problems, and abuse problems. Marital compatibility and others .2

Behavioral problems: such as aggressive behavior, hyperactivity, smoking, child behavioral problems, bullying -3

Psychological problems: such as depression, anxiety, phobias, schizophrenia, addiction, etc -4

Disability problems: such as motor disabilities, visual impairments, hearing impairments, developmental disorders (autism), multiple disabilities, etc -5

Economic problems: such as low income -6

Other problems: any other problems that cannot be classified within the previous categories -7

Several psychological tests were administered to a number of male .8  
and female college students, including the Shyness Scale, Self-  
Confidence Scale, Know Yourself Scale, and others. The results of these

tests and scales were presented to the students to help them understand their personalities

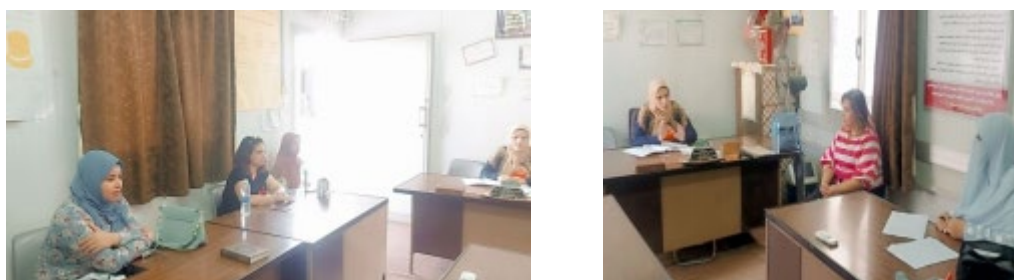


On 6/5/2024, the Center held a -24 workshop entitled (Social Relations among University Youth) for the
