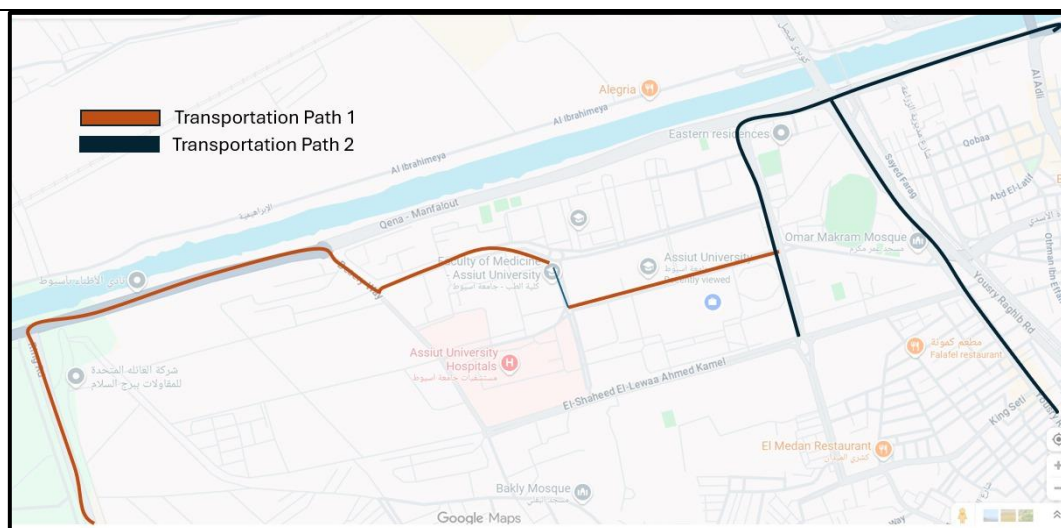

The administration of Assiut University has been keen to cater to people with disabilities by providing a dedicated pathway from the university entrances to all educational and administrative buildings. At least one accessible restroom is available in every educational building within the university. A map illustrating the pathways for people with disabilities is attached to this document and will be continuously updated as new obstacles arise.

Description:

Assiut University has taken significant and comprehensive measures to enhance the services provided to people with special needs, firmly embedding a culture of inclusivity across all campus operations. The university administration is deeply keen to ensure that students and staff with disabilities find every comfort and necessary support in their dealings with the university's diverse services. This commitment extends to streamlining educational services, simplifying administrative procedures, and enriching all aspects of student life. To physically manifest this dedication and ensure seamless navigation, the



university has developed and issued this detailed map, which clearly illustrates the specially designed and accessible pathways for people with special needs across the entire university campus.
