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Introduction

The nursery is considered a very important step in a child's life. During the nursery period, a child gets used to playing and interacting with his mates, learning to become self-reliant, acquiring new positive behavior, habits such as order, responsibility, give and take, comes out of the narrow range, which is the scope of dealing with his family, his life expands to include friends and colleagues. All these are important contributions to building a child's personality.

When the school period comes, the child has become qualified to deal with it, as the nursery has prepared the child to move from the stage of strong attachment to the mother and the home to a new important stage, the stage for education and study. Studies confirm that children who joined kindergarten or nursery school were found to be better in the level of language





development, social skills and interaction with other children who attended school directly without this stage.

Nursery human capabilities

First :nursery director office

She is the nursery educational leader, she is responsible for nursery organizational and administrative tasks. also, she strengthened collaboration between school and parents. responsible for investigating disputes and problems that may occur in the kindergarten and taking the necessary measures in them according to the regulations. It distributes work to all nursery employees, studies the technical directions to work in it, follows up the nursery workflow and performs other work assigned to it and supports it. Including nursery work team which consists of the deputy director and administrators of .the nursery





Second: nursery classes and activities

nursery consists of 3 classes, each class employs 3 supervisors + 2 workers. every class equipped to suit each age stage includes about 20 to 30 children, divided according to age as follows:

1-First joy class

It receives children from one to two years age, with 3 supervisors +2 janitors. It is equipped with baby carriages and a suitable place for children to sleep.





2-Flowers class

It receives children from the age of two to three and a half years, with 3 supervisors + 2 workers, supervisors try to create activities programs for children, taking into consideration individual differences as follows:-

In addition to these programs, nursery offered

1-musical activity with music teacher, twice a week with nursery children within a concert program that includes songs, plays and various chapters.

- 2- Sports activity twice a week by a karate coach.
- 3-responsible doctor for children medical supervision weekly.





Nursery entry requirements:-

- 1- child's age at least one-year-old; not more than six years.2-nursery joins application, made by the guardian to record child data.
- 3-A plastic file to keep the papers.
- 4-A certificate proving that one or both parents work at the university
- 5- An official transcript of the child's birth certificate, a computer certificate, or a copy of the birth certificate.
- 4- (6)photos of the child 4×6
- 7- An acknowledgement by e guardian for the one who receives the child.
- 8- The annual subscription, whose determined by nursery board directors, is paid to the treasury of the faculty of Early Childhood according to signed by the nursery director starting from 1/9 to 31/5
