




# How to apply in the university?

It is widely acknowledged that the transition from school to University is significant - the quantity of work, the pace at which material is covered and the conceptual complexity are all greater than students have experienced at school. Our experience has shown that many first-year students can overcome the difficult transition from high school to University by receiving a reduced learning load in their first year and by spreading the curriculum over a four year Period.
