

- I worked in the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department, in addition to working in the Embryology Unit and the Fetal Pulse Unit in 1998, and I also worked in emergency operations in the department.
- Between 1998 and 1999, she was responsible for clarifying family planning advice, especially the insertion of an IUD during a cesarean section.
- In 2005, two women's health hospitals were opened and the hospital was equipped with the director, especially the operations unit, and then it was entrusted with infection control in the hospital in addition to operations.
- In 2012, she became Deputy Director of the Nursing Department, then in 2021 she became Director of the Nursing Department.

Speech by Mrs. Saadia Jars Girgis

Nursing poses many challenges and requires a high professional level from its workers. In addition, the human component has a particularly central place in daily work. We believe in work based on ethical law, which respects the rights of the recipient of treatment, and takes into account their beliefs and social values. All nursing institutions see great importance in strengthening, developing, and growing human resources, in order for nurses to adapt themselves to the changes occurring in the health system, and to be able to provide quality treatment to the recipient of treatment and his or her family members.

A statement of some environmental and community service activities for the academic year 2022-2023

☐ What was accomplished during the period from January to June 2024:
☐ A symposium was held on dengue fever to learn about preventive measures for students, with the aim of spreading awareness and ways to prevent it, which targeted 50 female students from Hoda Shaarawi School.
☐ A symposium was held on climate change and its impact on the health of mothers and children at the Maternal University Children's Hospital to learn about preventive measures that targeted 15 mothers and fathers of children.
\square A symposium was held on developing the creative skills of students at the college to develop students' creative thinking, targeting 17 graduate nursing specialists.
☐ A symposium on informatics in nursing was held to raise awareness among internship students and the college about the technology used in the field of work and how to utilize it correctly. It targeted 58 members of the college's nursing internship students.
☐ A training course was held on basic life support for a group of internship students to train on cardiopulmonary resuscitation, which targeted all internship students (about 800 male and female students) on a monthly basis.
☐ A workshop was held for graduates entitled Environmental Safety in Critical Care Units and Emergency Medicines for graduates of the Faculty of Nursing at the University Hospital and Al-Mabarrah Hospital Reception and Critical Care. Which targeted 11 nursing specialists.
☐ A symposium was held on how to deal with chest allergies in children at the Maternal University Children's Hospital to learn about preventive measures. It targeted 20 mothers and 25 honors students.
☐ A training course on Basic Life Support was held for another group of internship students to train on cardiopulmonary resuscitation, targeting all internship students (about 800 male and female students) on a monthly basis.
☐ A symposium was held on the sudden death of internship students and nursing supervisors to raise awareness of the reasons that targeted 25 internship students at the college.

The charity exhibition for ready-made clothes opens, and the virtual training laboratory and cardiopulmonary resuscitation center is opened at the College of Nursing.





Climate changes and their impact on women's health

- Temperatures on our planet are changing now more than ever. Seasons have changed, heat waves and floods have become more common, glaciers have melted and food crises have become more severe.
- The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) noted that temperatures were 1 to 3 degrees Celsius higher than in 1990. Like many other changes in the world, this harmed some regions and benefited others but the costs of global warming and climate change It will increase over time, warns the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.
- Small changes in temperature tend to cause huge changes in the environment, with women and girls facing disproportionate impacts of climate change. They are driving climate solutions at all levels as farmers, workers, consumers, homemakers, activists, leaders and entrepreneurs.
- The climate crisis does not affect everyone equally. Women and girls face disproportionate impacts of climate change largely because they make up the majority of the world's poor, who rely heavily on local natural resources for their livelihoods.
- In rural areas in particular, women and girls are often responsible for securing food, water and firewood for their families. In times of drought and erratic rainfall, rural women work harder, walk further, and spend more time securing income and resources for their families. This would also expose them to gender-based violence, as climate change exacerbates existing conflicts, inequalities and vulnerabilities.
- When extreme weather disasters occur, women and children are 14 times more likely to die than men, mostly due to limited access to information, limited mobility, decision-making and resources. It is estimated that 4 out of 5 people displaced by the impacts of climate change are women and girls. Severe disasters can also disrupt essential services, including sexual and reproductive health care, exacerbating negative impacts on women and girls.
