



## Memorandum of Understanding for Cultural and Scientific Collaboration between University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna (Austria) and Assiut University (Egypt)

- On the basis of mutual understanding, respect and assistance, University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna (Austria), represented by its Rector, and Assiut University (Egypt), represented by its Rector, are interested in the development of cultural and scientific cooperation and the relationship that has already existed between the two Universities since 2009, agree on the following points:
- **Article 1**: Scientific and educational cooperation shall be undertaken in areas of mutual interest. Such cooperation will be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual advantage.
- **Article 2:** University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna and Assiut University agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in areas of mutual interest and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum (MOU).
  - University of Veterinary Medicine, Vienna and Assiut University agree on the following points:
- A) Encouragement of exchange of scientists (short visit) and academic activities in the fields of Molecular Biology, Poultry and Fish Diseases, Biochemistry, Herbal Medicine, Photochemistry and Plant Tissue Culture.
- B) Facilitation of the development of joint research programs conducted by scientists from both parties in the above-mentioned fields.

- Article 9: All changes and amendments to this memorandum must be agreed upon by mutual agreement, and the annexes of this memorandum will be valid if the parties of this memorandum should sign it after taking the required procedures, and it will be part of this memorandum and enjoys its legal power. At the end of the period of 5 years, the Memorandum of Understanding will be renewed after getting the required approval according to the laws of every country and the mutual consent of both Parties.
- **Article 10:** The parties shall try to settle amicably through direct negotiations any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this memorandum.
- **Article 11:** The Parties of This MOU are not committed to any extra financial or legal obligations and duties except what is mentioned in the light of this MOU.
